

Bill Title: Assisting small businesses licensed to sell liquor in Washington State.

Bill Number: HB 2831 Effective Date: 6/9/2016

Amends: Adds a new section to RCW 66.24, Amends RCW 66.28.340

## **Summary:**

Assists former and state and contract liquor stores, to help them compete with other retailers:

- The bill creates a "wine retailer reseller endorsement" that existing beer and wine specialty shops can obtain allowing them to sell wine at retail in original containers to other retailers for onpremise consumption (typically restaurants and bars).
- The bill also allows multiple wine and spirits licensees to jointly operate a warehouse facility for receipt and distribution of both wine and spirits for off-premise consumption.
- This space may be used to jointly negotiate a volume discount amongst the wine and spirits retailers participating in the shared warehouse facility or shared space within a retail location.

## How to apply for the wine retailer reseller endorsement:

The WSLCB will develop the rules according to HB 2831 to implement the endorsement. Once completed, the application will be found on the WSLCB website at: <a href="lcb.wa.gov">lcb.wa.gov</a>. Please complete and submit an application for the endorsement to the Washington State Liquor and Cannabis Board, Licensing Division. Each endorsement costs \$117 until 2017 when it will decrease to \$110.

## When the WSLCB Licensing Division receives the application:

- A Customer Service Specialist will be assigned to the application.
- Licensing staff will notify the licensee if any further documents are needed to process the request.
- Licensing staff will send a letter to the licensee approving the endorsement.
